Black Dyke Band's long history has seen it record music across all formats – from cylinders to 78" records, LP's, cassettes, CDs and DVDs – and record with the likes of The Beatles (appearing on the hit record *Yellow Submarine*), Peter Gabriel and Tori Amos. The band has also featured on television and movie soundtracks (including *Babe 2* and UK series *Ground Force*) and appeared on stage with Elton John, Phil Smith, Evelyn Glennie, Lesley Garrett and many more.

Black Dyke Band features many of the world's leading Baritone, Tenor Horn, Cornet, Euphonium, Trombone, Bass players and Percussionists, including Brett Baker, Richard Marshall, David Thornton, Alex Kerwin, Paul Lovatt-Cooper and Sandy Smith.
